7. New Business

- CAHL Items (Gurp)
 - o CAHL U9 Female Teams
 - Are you interested in participating in the U9 Female Group?
 - CMHA Response: Yes. CMHA currently has 11 players registered; Edyta will contact the families and see if we can get 2-3 more girls for this team.
 - How many teams will you want to have in the group?
 - CMHA Response: One.
 - What do you expect your team size to be for the number of players on your team?
 - CMHA Response: Current size is 11 players; we want to have a team of 14 players (to be determined).
 - If you have larger teams, would you be interested with larger teams doing split squad games with smaller teams (half the team plays one team while the other half plays another)
 - CMHA Response: No.
 - What do you feel is the correct number of games for a season for the U9 Female teams?
 - CMHA Response: Same as the co-ed teams.
 - Since travel may be an issue due the number of teams involved we will do what we can to minimize travel. Are you willing: Play more than 1 game in a day in one location? Do you want a different schedule format, if so what parameters are you looking for? Example weekend on / weekend off
 - CMHA Response: Play more than 1 game in a day in one location: Yes. It is hard to respond to this question; this depends on tiering.
 - Potentially parity may be an issue due to the number of teams. Is it more important to play all female teams than team parity in games OR team parity is important even if it reduces the number or variety of teams available to play against?
 - CMHA Response: Team parity CMHA is willing for our female team to play other co-ed teams.

CAHL U11 HADP (Hockey Alberta Development Program)

- In regards to the conference standings arrangements do you prefer: A North Tier and a South Tier with 6 or 7 teams in each or A single conference for the teams
 - CMHA Response: North and South Tiers is preferred. We prefer parity.
- Hockey Alberta is recommending 24 games for the regular season do you agree or not?
 - CMHA Response: If there is no tiering, 24 games for the regular season is acceptable.
- If you do not agree with the above 24 game recommendation, what do you think is the correct number of games?
 - CMHA Response: not applicable.
- Do you agree with the showcase weekend format used in the North Pilot project last season (playing every other weekend 3 or more games in one location)?
 - CMHA Response: We are interested in this concept, but we cannot host a showcase weekend due to lack of ice.
- Are you willing to provide ice for multiple hosted games on one day for various styles of schedule?
 - CMHA Response: We are interested in this concept, but we cannot host a showcase weekend due to lack of ice.

- Some schedule styles require 50% plus or more ice slots to schedule, are you willing or able to provide 18 to 24 home ice slots per team for this HADP program.
 - CMHA Response: We can provide the normal amount of ice (1/2 home games).
- Would you be interested in attending a showcase style weekend outside of the CAHL for 3
 games against teams in the North of the Province.
 - CMHA Response: Yes.

o CAHL U13 Tier 1 Group

- Are you interested in participating in the U13 Tier 1 group?
