U5 Review

Every player received a jersey, helmet decals and a toque for the 2022/23 season.

U7 Review

The U7 program received a TimBit jersey, socks and helmet decals. Jerseys will be in circulation for another year and new ones will be ordered for the 2023/24 season.

Socks will be ordered next month for the upcoming season.

Tim Hortons promo group sent Crosby lunch bags and will be given out in September.

U9 Review

The U9 program received 12 new composite goalie sticks. We have 9 full sets of goalie gear. A few sets will be repaired over the summer. New pads should be looked at for the 2024/25 season. We have 2 sets of right handed catchers set and may need to order another set if needed. Goalie bags are available should any zippers break during the season.

U11, U13 Review

For the 4th consecutive year, our U11 program has been registered with McDonalds and their atoMc program.

We did receive some feedback that jersey sizes were too large for a few of our players. Jersey kits sizes, #'s and socks are predetermined by McDonalds.

In January of this year we ordered 6 sets (home/away) of the smaller set as well as socks. These items will arrive sometime in August.

U15, U18 Review

The U15 and U18 programs will receive 4 sets (home&away) of new jerseys for the upcoming season. 2 sets for U15 and 2 sets for U18. An additional 4 sets (home&away) will be ordered for the 2024/25 season. This will help with the offset of different styles of jerseys we have on hand as well, these levels have the biggest registration growth in the association and a variety of sizing is required. In addition, these levels have the biggest loss of jerseys due to contact.

U21 Review

The U21 program received new sets of jerseys last year (2021/22) season and we will need to look at ordering new sets of jerseys for the 2024/25 season as well as additional set based on registrations if needed.

Supplier Overview

CMHA will continue to work with Eight33 for the 2023/2024 season. Our 3 year contract is up for renewal and in September a new RFP will be submitted for the next/continue supplier.

We will continue to order our jerseys through Eight33 and AK (Athletic Knit)

We have received positive feedback on the 3rd jersey design and will continue to use this logo as our 3rd jersey for the upcoming season.
