- Refrain from approaching the bench during a game situation unless summoned by a coach.
- Respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to hockey for my player.
- Accept defeat gracefully and teach my player that competing and doing your best, having fun, making friends and improving skills is as important as winning. I will offer praise for competing fairly and trying their hardest. By doing so, my player will be a winner and not feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
